INVITATION TO TENDER FOR

Supply of Medical Simulation Mannequins and Training Vests, 1 LOT

This is an invitation to tender for the supply of medical training and simulation equipment required for the implementation of Project ROUA00571, financed under the Interreg NEXT Programme Romania-Ukraine.

Contract Description and Object of Procurement

The objective of this simplified procurement procedure is the acquisition and delivery of 86 units of specialized medical simulation equipment under Project ROUA00571, financed by the Interreg NEXT Programme Romania-Ukraine.

The supply contract includes the provision of training mannequins with real-time digital feedback, circulatory simulation systems, choking management trainers (Heimlich models), and wearable intervention vests.

Maximum Budget Ceiling

The maximum total budget available for this contract is 72,200.00 EUR (including VAT, if applicable). Offers exceeding the maximum financial ceiling specified for the overall contract or for individual items will be rejected.

Eligibility and Origin

Participation is open on equal terms to all natural and legal persons (economic operators) participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers. All supplies delivered under this contract must comply with the rules of origin and nationality established by the Interreg NEXT Programme regulations.

Selection and Award Criteria

Selection Criteria: Technical capacity (proven experience in supplying medical or training equipment) and administrative compliance.

Award Criterion: The sole award criterion will be the Lowest Price among all tenders that fully meet the mandatory administrative and technical requirements.

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

Supplies to be Provided

The successful tenderer must deliver, unload, and test the equipment listed below in accordance with the minimum technical requirements:

Item 1: Heimlich mannequins with foreign bodies – 10 pieces

Item 2: Mannequins with real-time feedback on tablet, family pack – 10 pieces

Item 3: Compact mannequins with removable head and real-time feedback on tablet – 10 pieces

Item 4: Mannequins with blood circulation simulation through red light (Adults) – 10 pieces

Item 5: Mannequins with blood circulation simulation through red light (Baby) – 6 pieces

Item 6: Adult Heimlich vest – 20 pieces

Item 7: Child Heimlich vest – 20 pieces

Preparation and Submission of Tenders

Language: The tender, all correspondence, and documents related to the tender must be written in English/Romanian.

Submission Format: The tender must be submitted as a signed PDF document via email to vasile.vlasin@parintisalvatori.ro or delivered in a sealed envelope to the physical address of the Contracting Authority.

Tender Validity: Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days from the deadline for submission.

Currency: All financial offers and unit prices must be stated in Euros (EUR)/Romanian lei (RON).

Components of the Tender Submission

To be considered compliant, every tenderer must submit:

Administrative Details & Declaration: Signed company profile confirming eligibility and non-exclusion.

Technical Offer: A detailed data sheet explaining how the proposed products meet the technical parameters.

Financial Offer: The completed pricing sheet including delivery, transport, and unloading costs.

Exclusion Situations

Tenderers will be excluded from participation if they are bankrupt, subject to insolvency, have breached tax obligations, are involved in fraud/corruption, or have a conflict of interest with the project partners of contract ROUA00571

Delivery Terms and Location

Delivery Location: Romania, Maramureş County, 26 Main Street, Lunca de Jos, Moisei Commune

Incoterms: DDP (Delivered Duty Paid) – including all customs duties, local taxes, transport, and insurance.

Delivery Period: All equipment must be delivered and inspected within 60 calendar days from the signing of the supply contract.

By submitting a tender you accept to receive notification of the outcome of the procedure by electronic means. Such notification shall be deemed to have been received by you on the date upon which the contracting authority sends it to the electronic address you referred to in your offer.

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The period during which a tender will remain valid and shall not be modified in any respect is specified in point 7 of the Instructions to Tenderers.

Any contact between the contracting authority and the tenderer during the procedure is forbidden, save in exceptionally cases as foreseen in European legislation¹.

If you decide not to submit a tender, we would be grateful if you could inform us in writing, stating the reasons for your decision.
